All the land within our boundary is known locally as the "Dawes Bower" land. Coal mining here started in 1764 and was taken over by the NCB for deep coal mining until 1951. Afterwards it became a pumping and gas extraction facility for the main Granville Colliery. It was permanently closed in 1979. The woods are therefore sculptured by old pit spoil heaps and rail track pathways which nature and the club has made into a magical environment for naturists to enjoy.

The woodland is open to all our naturist friends to ramble freely and if you wish use the barbeque areas (Please inform reception first). The woodland is both secure and private and there is no access by the public. We do ask you to take special care when using all the steps particularly the very steep Zig-Zag steps, particularly when wet as they can become very slippy. Users of the woodlands facility do so at their own risk and TNC ltd will not accept responsibility for damage, accident or loss.
